Campus life at UAHuntsville is as vibrant as ever with over 100 student organizations, including a community of fraternity and sorority organizations, a state-of-the art fitness facility, numerous on campus events, opportunities to participate in intramural athletics, an extensive intercollegiate athletics program, and attractive residence halls and dining venues. A new Student Life Center on Holmes Avenue at the north end of the planned Campus Greenway that will connect Lakeside Drive to Holmes Avenue is slated to open in fall 2013.
