.....young Ph.D.'s are waiting in the wings for jobs. Institutions are also struggling to manage faculty renewal at a time when the position left behind by a retired faculty member might be lost to budget cuts.

Their work isn't just a way to earn a living, but instead a major part of their identity. And that can make it difficult for professors to give up their jobs.



Voluntary Retirement Option Plan for Tenured Faculty

- Voluntary participation
- Provides financial incentive tied to salary to those who choose to retire from UAH
- Eligibility
 - Tenured faculty (up to and including Deans)
 - Retirement eligible as of retirement date
 - 60+10 yrs service or
 - 25 yrs service
- >40% tenured eligible; >20% FT faculty eligible
- Launch date: August 31, 2012
