The meeting was called to order by Ann Lee at 11:00 a.m.

Minutes of the last meeting:

A motion was made by Keisha Askew and seconded by Crystal Lee to approve the minutes from the last meeting, November 16, 2005.

A presentation was made by Julia Boehme of the Wellness Center and David Kyle of HPE on a new fitness program, "Just Move It", which will be offered by the Wellness Center.

This will be an eight week program and will start on February 20, 2006 and end on April 17, 2006.

A link will be provided for registration on-line for those who are interested in participating and who have computer access. For those without computer access, the Staff Senate will assist with the registration process. Registration deadline is February 17, 2006.

Old Business:

ADHOC, a group consisting of UAH Faculty and Staff, is discussing an on campus wellness center for the University.

A healthcare survey will be distributed campus wide by the Staff Senate to all faculty and staff. The survey will gather information regarding interest in a Wellness Center and the utilization of it. Surveys should be returned no later than February 3, 2006 to Ann Lee.

Ann announced that the 2005 Christmas Reception was a success. She requested that the University contribute funds toward the Christmas Reception in the future. Ray Pinner stated that the President has always contributed in times past, but that he would check into it. She also noted that Keisha Askew will be in charge of the Reception in 2006.

New Business:

Ann gave a report on the Administrative Council Meeting. Discussion included the progressing of the Athletic field, (7) emergency phones that have already been installed on campus, campus lighting projects still in progress, as well as other construction on campus.

Cathi Curtis gave a report on Homecoming which is scheduled for 2/1 – 2/4/06. She asked that we encourage people to attend the activities that have been planned.

Ray Pinner gave a follow-up on the construction taking place on campus. More construction is expected, i.e., the Applied Science Building project, Madison Hall parking lot, and the Sanderson sub-division project.

He also reported that the budget that the Governor presented looks like we'll have another good year and that the University stands to receive an increase in appropriations.
