UAH to host boccia clinic in partnership with Huntsville Parks and Recreation

What: The University of Alabama in Huntsville (UAH) Ability Sport Network will partner with Huntsville Parks and Recreation to host a free boccia clinic.

When: Saturday, July 22, 2023 10 a.m. to noon

Where: Optimist Recreation Center, 703 Oakwood Avenue, Huntsville, AL 35811

About: Boccia, a Paralympic sport, is a game of strategy and accuracy that is played by people with many types of impairments. The sport is played on a flat, smooth surface, where players must throw or roll colored balls as close as possible to a white target ball, known as the "jack." The player, pair or team with the most balls near the jack is the winner.

Mark Flora-Swick will be joining the UAH Ability Sport Network to lead the clinic. Flora-Swick has been a coach and official for USA Boccia at the international level. The clinic is free and available to anyone aged six and up.
