

RESOLUTION NO. 54-109

WHEREAS the City of Huntsville in a survey for underground sources of water supply in and near the City of Huntsville, Alabama, caused a well to be bored or constructed on the real estate hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council of the City of Huntsville that the City of Huntsville acquire and secure such well for the purpose of securing a water supply sufficient for the inhabitants of the City of Huntsville; and


WHEREAS in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Huntsville, it is necessary for obtaining a water supply, that the real estate hereinafter described and the well situate thereon, be acquired by the City of Huntsville.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Huntsville that it is the opinion and judgment of the City Council of the City of Huntsville that it is necessary for the City of Huntsville to obtain and acquire the real estate hereinafter described in this resolution and the well located on said real estate for the City of Huntsville's use and purpose in obtaining a water supply sufficient for its inhabitants.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Huntsville that the Mayor of the City of Huntsville be, and he is hereby authorized to attempt to acquire for and on behalf of the City of Huntsville by purchase from the owner or owners thereof that certain well located on the lot or parcel of real estate which is hereinafter described in this resolution, together with the lot or parcel of real estate upon which said well is located, which said lot or parcel of real estate is situate near the City of Huntsville, in Madison County, Alabama and is particularly described as follows, to wit:

A lot 40 feet east and west and 60 feet north and south in the southwest corner of the following described tract: Beginning at a point on the north margin of the Athens Pike, which point is 10 chains east and .70 chains north from the southwest corner of Section 33, Township 3, Range 1 West; thence north $1\frac{1}{4}$ degrees west 11.50 chains to an iron stake; thence west parallel with the section line 2.03 chains to an iron stake; thence south $1\frac{1}{4}$ degrees east 11.10 chains to an iron stake on the north margin of Athens Pike; thence along the north margin of said pike south $78\frac{1}{4}$ degrees east 2.03 chains to the place of beginning, and containing 2.25 acres, more or less,
