

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Madison County Board of Commissioners beretofore, on May 21, 1962, resolved to condemn, jointly with the City of Huntsville, certain lands situated in Madison County for donation to the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama to be used for educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said resolution, said lands have been condemned and title theorete finally vested jointly in the City of Huntsville and Madison County by decree of the Probate Court of Madison County entered the 22nd day of October, 1960; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of Madison County that the interest of Madison County so acquired in said lands, the same being described in 7 separats embilits hereto attached and marked, for identification, Embilit 1 through Embilit 7, inclusive, be conveyed to the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama to be used for educational purposes by the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, in the name of Madison County and came attested and the scal of the county affixed upon the deed of conveyance thereof by the Clerk Auditor, pursuant to the purpose for which said lands were acquired.
