AFFIDAVIT OF WILLIE FAY JONES

My name is Willie Fay Jones. I am 50 years old, and have lived in Madison County, Alabama, all of my life. I was born and raised on the property hereinafter described. I was one of the defendants named in Case No. 12257, in the Probate Courts of Madison County, Alabama, concerning condemnation proceedings on the hereinafter described property.

The property hereinafter described was owned by my grand-mother, Lizzie Jones, who is now deceased. During Lizzie Jones's life time, she had born to her four children as follows:

1. Haywood Jones, now deceased
2. Emma Blair, now deceased
3. Queen Anne Jordan, now deceased
4. Tommie Lee Jones, now deceased.

1. Haywood Jones died without issue and has no living wife.
2. Emma Blair died without issue and has no living husband.
3. Queen Anne Jordan had the following named children:

Charlie Eldridge;  
and Josie Jordan.

4. Tommy Lee Jones had the following named children:

Willie Fay Jones, the affiant  
Lloyd Jones, now living  
Reva Jones Boyd, now living  
and Lillie Mae Jones, now deceased.

Josie Jordan left surviving her a male child, named Neal Collier. Neal Collier has not been seen nor heard of for the past 20 years and I presume that he is dead.

Lillie Mae Jones left surviving her a daughter, whose name is Lillie Mae Crawford. This was the only child born to Lillie Mae Jones during her life time and as far as I know, Lillie Mae Jones, has no living husband.

After the death of my father, Tommie Lee Jones, my mother, Odell Jones, married again to a man named Chris Jones and that they had born to them during the life time of my Mother, Odell Jones, two daughters, named as follows:

Seleste Jones, a half sister on my mother's side.  
and Bethel Jones Hill, also a half sister on my mother's side

The property owned by Lizzie Jones, my grand-mother is described as follows:

A lot 40 feet east and west and 60 feet north and south in the southwest corner of the following described tract: Beginning at a point on the north margin of the Athens Pike, which point is 10 chains east and ,70 chains north from the southwest corner of Section 33, Township 3, Range 1 West; thence north  $1\frac{1}{4}$  degree west 11.50 chains to a iron stake; thence west parallel with the section line 2.03 chains to an iron stake, thence south  $1\frac{1}{4}$  degree east 11.10 chains to an iron stake on the north margin of Athens Pike; thence along the north margin of said Pike south  $78\frac{1}{4}$  degree East 203 chains to the place of beginning,

and containing 2.25 acres, more or less, together with the well located on said real estate, all of which is located in Madison County, State of Alabama.
